GOSPEL: ST JOHN 18: 33-37 'Mine is not a kingdom of this world' (Vs 36)

ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT will take place every Thursday, starting after 10.00am Mass and finishing at 12.00noon.

- Next Sunday, 28 November, is the First Sunday of Advent (the first of four Sundays of Advent) and the first day of the new Church year.
- Advent gets its name from the Latin word adventus, meaning 'coming' or 'arrival'.
- The Scripture Readings for the Season of Advent blend the spiritual preparation for celebrating the coming of the Christ Child at Christmas with the theme of preparation for the Second and Final Coming of the Lord (the Parousia).
- The traditional colour of Advent is purple or violet, which symbolises the penitential spirit of the season. The priest wears purple vestments for Mass.
- In this coming liturgical year, Year C of the three-year cycle, we will listen, most Sundays, to the Gospel of St Luke.
